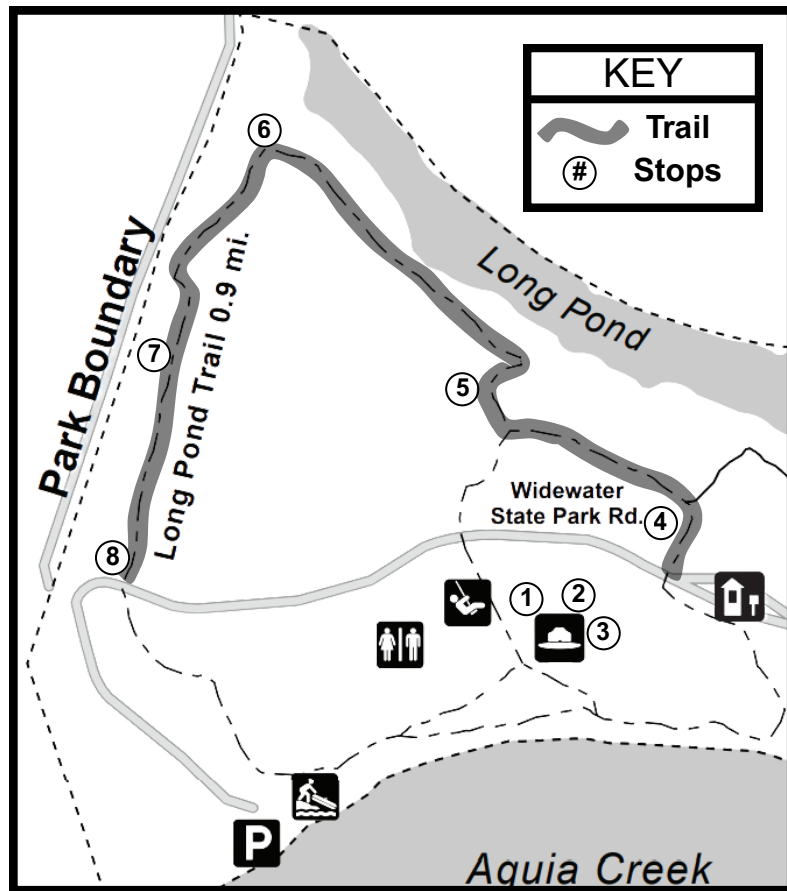

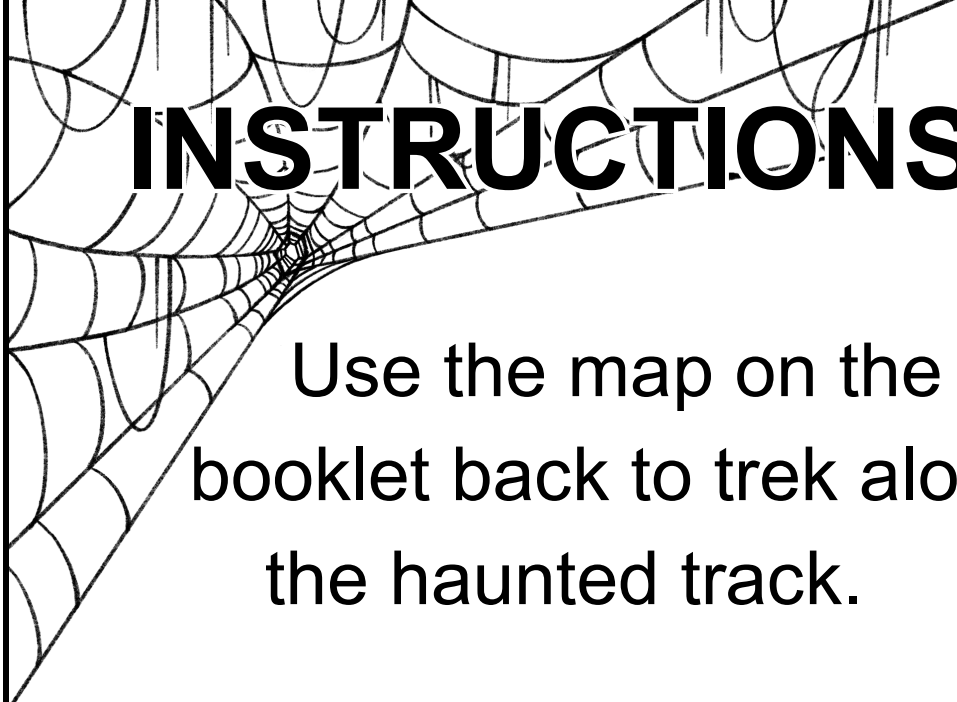

At each of the stops you will find, a puzzle, question, or sly rhyme.

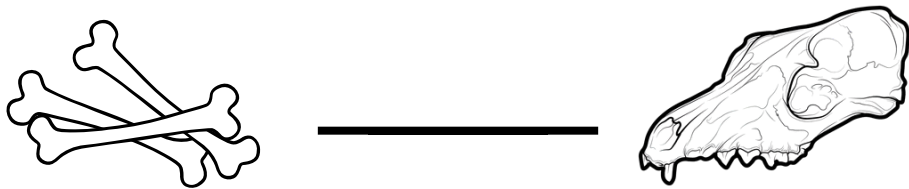
Record your answers and watch your feet, at the end of the trail you will get a sweet treat!

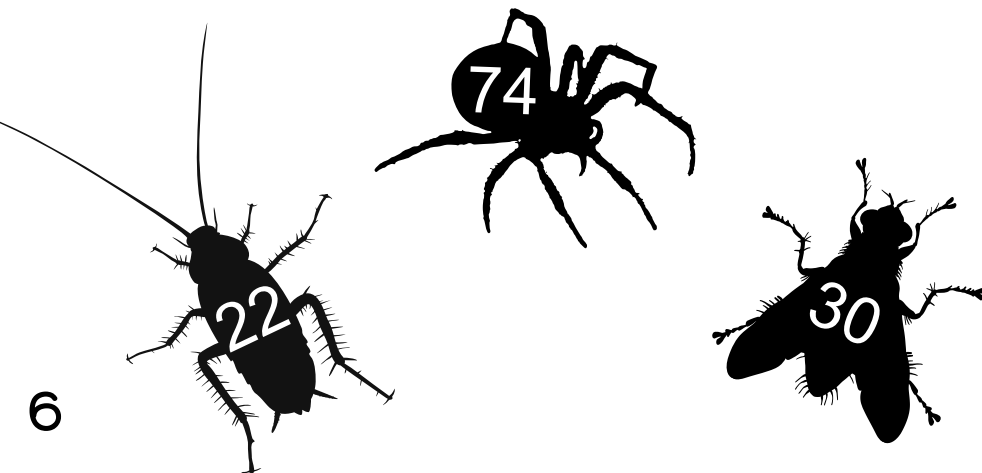
How many native bat species are found at this park? Quick! Look in the trees before it gets too dark.
