Go for a run on the **5K Cross Country Trail** within our trail system. The 3.1 mile trail starts in front of the gift shop.

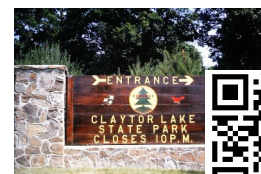
