

Trail Etiquette

High Bridge Trail is designed for hiking, bicycling and horseback riding. Trail etiquette is of the utmost importance here. Be sure to:

- Ride right and pass left.
- Use vocal signals when passing.
- Maintain a safe and courteous speed.
- Be courteous and respectful of other visitors.



Leave What You Find

- Preserve the past: Examine but don't touch cultural and historical structures and artifacts.
- Leave rocks, plants and other natural objects as you find them.
- Don't introduce or transport non-native species.

Respect Wildlife

- Observe wildlife from a distance. Don't follow or approach wild animals.
- Never feed wild animals. It can make them sick, alter their natural behavior, and expose them to predators and other dangers.
